

## Identify Purpose

*Psa 139:15-18 KJV My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, [and] curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being imperfect; and in thy book all [my members] were written, [which] in continuance were fashioned, when [as yet there was] none of them. How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them! [If] I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.*

- A. Your gifts and callings are formed within you in the womb,
- B. God plans and thoughts about you are innumerable.

The Divine plan for Joseph: I create you as a world leader, an interpreter of dreams, with gifts of leadership and wisdom.

*Gen 37:5-11 KJV And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told [it] his brethren: and they hated him yet the more. And he said unto them, Hear, I pray you, this dream which I have dreamed: For, behold, we [were] binding sheaves in the field, and, lo, my sheaf arose, and also stood upright; and, behold, your sheaves stood round about, and made obeisance to my sheaf. And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words. And he dreamed yet another dream, and told it his brethren, and said, Behold, I have dreamed a dream more; and, behold, the sun and the moon and the eleven stars made obeisance to me. And he told [it] to his father, and to his brethren: and his father rebuked him, and said unto him, What [is] this dream that thou hast*

*dreamed? Shall I and thy mother and thy brethren indeed come to bow down ourselves to thee to the earth? 11 And his brethren envied him; but his father observed the saying.*

- A. Every attack against you from sinful man is to stop you from fulfilling God's plans.
- B. Patterns of attacks tend to start early in childhood. Before age seven the brain is setting patterns and systems. (Based in God's Word or based in man's sinful nature, generational curses or our own sinful protective responses of coping or responding. Sometimes as far back as in the womb itself.
- C. A baby in the womb through his spirit which is made in God's image feels and knows what is going on in the home and can even sin, Is 48:8, Psalms 58:3.

Spirit Led Healing: God will lead you in the way you should go to receive wholeness through Him. This is the point of the Holy Spirit. It is also the point of being faced with circumstances so we will change our false systems and find God's. For the believer the trials we face bring us to the wisdom we need so that we will change. This is the process of deliverance, healing, and even God using the gifts to bring confirmation to us.

Whole healing: Life encounters with Jesus where He heals the spirit from wrong association and influence, the heart (mind, will, and emotions) from soul wounds and traumatic events and sin places lie based pain and human self-preservation responses and systems with His Truth (The Word of God).

Deliverance: The process of breaking the power of demonic strongholds and human sin based self-preservation beliefs and sinful responses in a person life through repentance, forgiveness, and death to self-obedience that gives all authority to Jesus through the Word and the power of the Holy Spirit, causing demonic spirits and their sinful strongholds to be broken so the person goes free to live in intimacy with Christ and fulfill God's original purpose and will. This is a journey of growth in Christ.

*[Jer 1:5 KJV] 5 Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, [and] I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.*

*[Gal 1:13-16 KJV] For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the church of God, and wasted it: And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers. But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called [me] by his grace, To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood.*

Satan through his lies and deceit has determined to destroy us because we are called to bear God's image. While on this earth we do our part to complete the mission in the middle of a battle. As human beings in a

fight we do not see the complete fulfillment and are given examples of this in Scripture.

*[1Co 10:1-11 KJV] 1 Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; 2 And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; 3 And did all eat the same spiritual meat; 4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ. 5 But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness. 6 Now these things were our examples, to the intent we should not lust after evil things, as they also lusted. 7 Neither be ye idolaters, as [were] some of them; as it is written, The people sat down to eat and drink, and rose up to play. 8 Neither let us commit fornication, as some of them committed, and fell in one day three and twenty thousand. 9 Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents. 10 Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed of the destroyer. 11 Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come.*

*[Heb 11:33-40 KJV] 33 Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions, 34 Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. 35 Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might*

*obtain a better resurrection: 36 And others had trial of [cruel] mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment: 37 They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented; 38 (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and [in] mountains, and [in] dens and caves of the earth. 39 And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise: 40 God having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.*

While we walk and are growing in Christ, we are in a battle with error and human fallibility. While this is the case none of us should abort what God has started in us. What we offer is imperfect, but He is the finisher, the perfecter of those things in our lives that are in complete.

*[Mat 5:17-18 KJV] 17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. 18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.*

*[Rom 8:4 KJV] 4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.*

*[Heb 12:1-2 KJV] 1 Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset [us], and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, 2 Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of [our] faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.*

*[Phl 1:6 KJV] 6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform [it] until the day of Jesus Christ:*

The goal is to never give up and forfeit the goal of what you were created for. We must know that Jesus is always at work saving us from every destructive force internal, and external. The process of deliverance is letting God expose it in all locations. Jesus has valued us as His own, and our job is to live in Him, move in Him, and then have our being.

*[1Sa 25:29 KJV] 29 Yet a man is risen to pursue thee, and to seek thy soul: but the soul of my lord shall be bound in the bundle of life with the LORD thy God; and the souls of thine enemies, them shall he sling out, [as out] of the middle of a sling.*

*[Psa 36:9 KJV] 9 For with thee [is] the fountain of life: in thy light shall we see light.*

*[Act 17:27-28 KJV] 27 That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: 28 For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring.*

*[2Co 13:4 KJV] 4 For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you.*

*[1Jo 4:9 KJV] 9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him.*

When we remain in Him then we can live out our identity. Our relationship with Jesus is what we value in and has determined us to be valuable to God

(Matt 10:31, Luke 12:70). This is what the fight is about. It is all about you not fulfilling your purpose. We must find our identity in Christ and fulfill it. It is hard to fulfill purpose without seeking the Lord's wholeness on the journey. This is the benefit of following Christ. He is leading you to be made whole as you pursue a relationship with Him and fulfill the Father's will for your life.

*[Eph 2:10 KJV] 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.*

*[Gal 2:20 KJV] 20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.*

*[Jhn 15:16 KJV] 16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and [that] your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.*

*[Jer 29:11 KJV] 11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.*

*[2Co 5:18-19 KJV] 18 And all things [are] of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.*

*[Col 1:27 KJV] 27 To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory, Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all*

*wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: 29 Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily*

Ask the Father to reveal everything He spoke into you in the womb.

As you Hear God write it down.

Speak it out loud over yourself on a regular basis.

Post what you have written with scripture so you can see it.

Agree with the Words of your Creator and they will come to pass.

We all come into agreement with one another releasing our faith together. We activate God's love and wait in hope for Christ to make us whole as we seek His will.

*[Gal 4:19 KJV] 19 My little children, of whom I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you,*
