

Pattern 2 Core Lies

[Heb 10:38-39 KJV] 38 Now the just shall live by faith: but if [any man] draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. 39 But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul.

When we speak of the term inner healing, we must cause this terminology to find its limits within the pages of Scripture. In the area of healing, you can find it in the statement “whole”. There are two Greek words for this use the first insinuates growth to wholeness “hygiēs” adj(John 5:6-15, Acts 4:10), the other is the word “sōzō” verb which means safe, sound, rescued from destruction, injury or peril (Mark 5:28.34. Luke 17:19.33.) The second is based in the scripture “they that endure to the end shall be saved.” This insinuates a growing salvation or progression.

1Th 5:23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and [I pray God] your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Pro 23:4-7 Labour not to be rich: cease from thine own wisdom. 5 Wilt thou set thine eyes upon that which is not? for [riches] certainly make themselves wings; they fly away as an eagle toward heaven. 6 Eat thou not the bread of [him that hath] an evil eye, neither desire thou his dainty meats: 7 For as he thinketh in his heart, so [is] he: Eat and drink, saith he to thee; but his heart [is] not with thee.

- A. To understand soul salvation, we must understand that lies, false wisdom, accusation, and evil thoughts originate in the unseen heart which includes the soul.

B. We must deny ourselves the lies the enemy has offered as well as his carnal remedies.

The Divine plan for Joseph: I created you as a world leader, an interpreter of dreams, with gifts of leadership and wisdom.

Gen 37:8. 10. 23-24.28 KJV And his brethren said to him, Shalt thou indeed reign over us? or shalt thou indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words 10 And he told [it] to his father, and to his brethren: and his father rebuked him, and said unto him, What [is] this dream that thou hast dreamed? Shall I and thy mother and thy brethren indeed come to bow down ourselves to thee to the earth? 11 And his brethren envied him; but his father observed the saying. 23 And it came to pass, when Joseph was come unto his brethren, that they stript Joseph out of his coat, [his] coat of [many] colours that [was] on him; 24 And they took him, and cast him into a pit: and the pit [was] empty, [there was] no water in it. ... 28 Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty [pieces] of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

A. Rejection, Abandonment, Betrayal, Violence, Humiliation.

B. Core Beliefs: I am a throw away, I can't trust my brothers (testing), My father doesn't love me. I can only trust myself. My gifts are so powerful (non-submission), I hate what God has shown me. I shut down on God. Trust no one. Test came back to him (would he fulfill the dream or destroy his family)

The Word of God is given to us to correct this type of wrong belief, imagination, and soul issue. Not only is it to be heard, but our deliverance also happens when we obey the Word of God.

Jer 16:12 And ye have done worse than your fathers; for, behold, ye walk every one after the imagination of his evil heart, that they may not hearken unto me:

Pro 28:26 He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered.

Ecc 9:3 This [is] an evil among all [things] that are done under the sun, that [there is] one event unto all: yea, also the heart of the sons of men is full of evil, and madness [is] in their heart while they live, and after that [they go] to the dead.

Heb 4:12 For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

[2Co 10:4-6 KJV] 4 (For the weapons of our warfare [are] not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ; 6 And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

One of the greatest issues in our day is that humanistic counseling is telling people to believe in themselves. When we have core lies, we cannot put our trust in them because they will cause issues to appear in our lives we do not want. Believing lies opens the door for the enemies plans to come to pass, this is why the lies are placed there to hinder us in the knowledge of the truth.

Pro 3:5-7 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

Jer 10:23 O LORD, I know that the way of man [is] not in himself: [it is] not in man that walketh to direct his steps.

Rom 12:16 [Be] of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

1Co 8:2 And if any man think that he knoweth any thing, he knoweth nothing yet as he ought to know.

[Jhn 8:43-45 KJV] 43 Why do ye not understand my speech? [even] because ye cannot hear my word. 44 Ye are of [your] father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he

*speakech a lie, he speakech of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
45 And because I tell [you] the truth, ye believe me not.*

When we have wrong beliefs within ourselves it is hard to hear the truth. Satan will always tun the truth into a further hurt by making you feel less than. This is his trick and a form of victim mentality. If you can hear the truth and desire it, it will set you free and release healing and life. So many people with trauma let the devil use the guilt of the past or the traumatic event to make them live a life of self-blame, even concerning the Truth of God that is to be received in faith so God will have His perfect work. The past trauma has burnt false belief into us as a memory, and this places us on a cycle of repeat.

Isa 43:16-19 Thus saith the LORD, which maketh a way in the sea, and a path in the mighty waters; 17 Which bringeth forth the chariot and horse, the army and the power; they shall lie down together, they shall not rise: they are extinct, they are quenched as tow. 18 Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. 19 Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, [and] rivers in the desert.

A. This is not saying to not deal with the pain, but it is saying you cannot live in the trauma forever.

Phl 3:13-14 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but [this] one thing [I do], forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.

2Co 5:17 Therefore if any man [be] in Christ, [he is] a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

A. We must put on Christ and the new life and that takes allowing God word to be our desire.

How you receive the Word of God and respond to God's truth will determine whether you allow yourself to believe and activate faith or if you continue to stay where you are. Satan takes everything that belongs to God and tries to distort its use. This is why our emotions burn in trauma and its responses. Gods' intent was to burn His Word and Spirit into every part of our being so He would get all of our responses. When Satan accesses us through life trauma, or even our own trauma we now must let God's word be rewritten in our hearts. This is why the fire of the Holy Spirit is so important. This is why God should own our minds, will, and EMOTIONS.

Luk 24:32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?

Psa 39:3 My heart was hot within me, while I was musing the fire burned: [then] spake I with my tongue,

Jer 20:9 Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But [his word] was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not [stay].

Act 2:3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Facing trauma is the way that the soul is saved and it is training us to overcome obstacles and weaknesses within our selves so the God can be made strong in

us. This is the process of becoming mature in Christ. The longer we stop the Word from working mightily in us the longer it is mere head knowledge and cannot truly change our hearts, thereby affecting our whole person and our life.

Heb 5:14 But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Isa 7:15 Butter and honey shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil, and choose the good.
